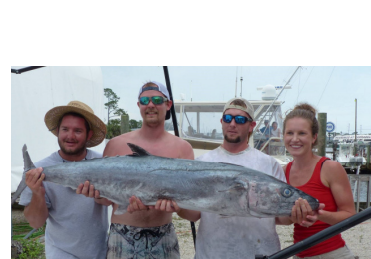

The Big Bend Saltwater Classic was held last weekend and is a family oriented fishing tournament. Launched in 1989 by The Organization for Artificial Reefs, Inc. (OAR), a private, non-profit, marine interest group based in Tallahassee, all of the proceeds derived from the event are used to expand and develop a system of artificial reefs in the NE Gulf of Mexico. According to Florida Sportsman Magazine, the tournament ranks among the top saltwater fishing tournaments, by participation, with an average of 700 competitors in recent years. The first tournament was held at Shield's Marina in St. Marks. This was changed in 1990 to Panacea Harbor Marina, then in 1991 **The Moorings of Carrabelle**. During the years of 2006 to 2012, the tournament was held at **The Carrabelle Boat Club**. In 2013, **The Moorings of Carrabelle** once again became the headquarters for the 25th annual Big Bend Saltwater Classic.
